- For **walk in would care**, and for any other health related support/information/referral walk in to the health unit an ask for duty nurse at the reception
- For **Free Harm** reduction supplies, along with harm reduction education and referrals to health services, addictions services, and other social supports. Needle exchange services include distribution of clean needles, sterile water, and alcohol wipes; disposal of used needles; and health information to encourage safer injection practices. **Just go to the reception of these public health units and ask for HR supplies**
- For **Nurse Referral, ask for duty nurse**
- **Free unlimited condoms at the reception**
- All of these locations also offers opioid users with free **Take Home Naloxone Kits (Narcan)**
